
## **Kashaya Words Customer Handoff Document**

## User Manual




This is the home screen of our Kashaya Words app.




To learn more about where the idea for the app came from or who were the developers that worked to produce this app, you can press the 'About' button in the main page.




To learn more about the voices you hear in the word pronunciations, you can click the 'Speakers' button to find out more about who helped produce these recordings.




To learn more about the Kashaya alphabet, you can click the 'Symbols' button in the main page.




By pressing the Word tab located at the bottom of the screen on an Android phone (or on the upper left on an Android tablet), you can see the broader categories the words are classified into.




Pressing one of the broader categories opens up a selection of smaller categories associated with the chosen category. To choose a smaller category, choose from one of the options provided.



After selecting a small category, you can see all the words in the specific category. Scrolling down you can see the entire list of words arranged in the following fashion: a picture representing the word, that when clicked plays the pronunciation, a button to the bottom left that switches from the English and Kashaya spellings, and a text on the bottom right that identifies the speaker of the recording.




By choosing the Quiz tab on the bottom navigation bar, you see a selection of categories that you can check and uncheck. The quiz content will only come from the categories that are checked. To highlight all selections, you can choose the 'Select All' box. Once all categories are selected, press 'START' on the top right to launch the quiz.




On each quiz page, you will see a fraction on the top left that indicates "what number question you are on / the total number of questions in this category" (the maximum number of questions per quiz was set to be 10). A few seconds after the page loads, a pronunciation of a word will play and you should choose the correct image that corresponds with the word spoken.

'Back to Quiz' takes you back to the screen where you can select the categories you want to be tested on. 'Play Word' repeats the pronunciation of the word being tested. 'Hint' eliminates one incorrect answer for you (can only be chosen once) and 'Show Answer' highlights the correct answer.




When the correct answer is chosen or highlighted (by the 'Show Answer' button), the correct image corresponding to the pronunciation will be highlighted in yellow. You can press 'Next' to see the next quiz question.



If an incorrect image is selected (or by pressing the 'Hint' button), the image will fade out and the user will not be able to make the selection again.



At the end of the quiz, you will see Congratulations page that indicates that you have completed the quiz and are given the following options: 'Replay' which replays the quiz with the previous categories you had selected; 'Main Quiz' which takes you back to the page where you can select new categories; 'See Score' where you can see how you did on your current quiz.



The score page show total number of questions, total correct answers and number of hints you received,
