They all are, though, in one meaning or another; moreover, I'm sure that the list is not complete.
There are very few nouns that end in invariant /ठ/. So far I've been able to find lathe, tithe, and scythe.

I expect that some of you will have different pronunciations of some of these words and/or different judgments about how the plural is formed, but that shouldn't change the overall picture much.
